

All chapters and colonies are expected to participate in the National Accreditation Program to ensure they are meeting the basic expectations of the National Fraternity. Chapters/colonies will have to opportunity to submit documentation throughout the semester. For consistency, all forms and reports will be due on the 7<sup>th</sup> of every month and can be accessed on the national website.

In addition, the National Office will update the chapter/colony's Accreditation Status on a weekly basis to provide all members, advisors, and alumni with a better understanding of where the chapter/colony stands on a national level.









