

All chapters and colonies are expected to participate in the National Accreditation Program to ensure they are meeting the basic expectations of the National Fraternity. Chapters/colonies will have to opportunity to submit documentation throughout the semester. For consistency, all forms and reports will be due on the 7th of every month and can be accessed on the national website.

In addition, the National Office will update the chapter/colony's Accreditation Status on a weekly basis to provide all members, advisors, and alumni with a better understanding of where the chapter/colony stands on a national level.

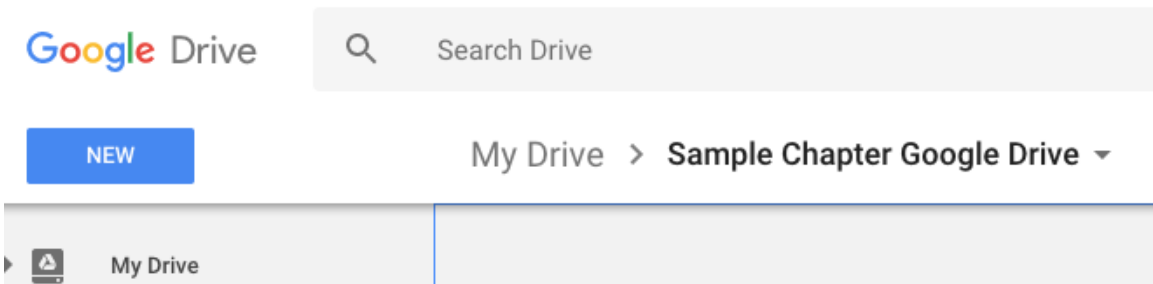
